- All administrators and volunteers must understand and adhere to the WAFC By Law 1- The Spirit of Junior Football
- Remember that children participate for the enjoyment and playdown the importance of rewards.
- Ensure that the rules, equipment, length of games and training schedule take into consideration the age, ability, and maturity level of participating children.
- Ensure that adequate supervision is provided by qualified and competent coaches and officials.
- Ensure that parents, coaches, sponsors, trainers, and participants understand their responsibilities regarding fair play.
- Ensure that your behaviour is consistent with the principles of good sporting behaviour.
- Actively promote positive Game Day Environment with Junior Football and the importance of E-Point structures to the game.
- Condemn unsporting behaviour and promote respect for all opponents.
- Ensure promotion, well-being and safety of umpires and encourage good sportsmanship before, during and after matches.
- Ensure positive player/umpire relationships are continually developed.
- Ensure that equal opportunities for participation in sports are made available to all children, regardless of ability, size, shape, gender, age, disability, or ethnic origin.
