

COACHING COORDINATOR

The coaching coordinator acts as a proactive liaison point between the coaching staff for all the clubs teams and the committee. The role also extends to support and mentoring all the clubs coaching staff.

Coaching Coordinator duties may include but are not limited to:

- Seek out interest in coaching roles for an upcoming seasons.
- Provide a short list of coaches for each team across the club to the executive committee.
- Support the executive committee in appointing coaches for each team within the club at the beginning of the season.
- Preside over coaches meetings and work with coaching staff to provide the players the best possible learning environment.
- Attend and represent coaching staff at monthly club committee meetings.
- Provide any support material and information to assist coaches in doing their job.
- Ensure all coaches complete an appropriate level coaching course run by the AFL each season at the clubs expense.
- Assist coaches where necessary during training sessions.
- Communicate and implement AFL by laws and modified rules as they apply.
