The below Code of Conduct is applicable to all Hills Rangers Club Players

- All players must understand and adhere to the WAFC By Law 1- The Spirit of Junior Football.
- Play for the fun of it and not just to please parents and coaches.
- Play by the rules.
- Be a good sport; applaud good plays whether they are by your teammates or the opposing players.
- Be prepared to take responsibility for your actions.
- Work equally hard for yourself and for your team, your team's performance will benefit so will you.
- Never argue with the umpire or an official, discuss the matter with your coach following the match.
- The verbal abuse of umpires or other players is not acceptable.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, or provoking an opponent isn't acceptable.
- Treat all players as you wish to be treated.
- Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another teammate or opposing player.
- Respect your coach, teammates and opposing players in an equal manner.
- Avoid using derogatory language or swearing.
