

FEMALE DELEGATE/PFL COORDINATOR (Perth Football League)

This role is to represent female and colts football as well as being the main point of call for the Perth Football League.

Female Delegate/PFL Coordinator duties may include but are not limited to:

- Attend monthly committee meetings.
- Arrange the seasons umpires.
- Be the liaison between the Amateurs women's team and any future colts teams and the committee.
- Ensure that all initiatives are approved by the committee prior to commencing.
- Aid in seeking sponsorship for the Amateur team.
- Form part of the Amateur women's leadership team, which also includes captain, vice-captain, coach, assistant coach, coaching co-ordinator, and team manager.
- Inform the team manager of upcoming events, any requirements they are required to fulfil.
- Be a recipient of emails from the Perth Football League and assign/action anything under the direction of the club's secretary.
- Organise end of season function and liaise with club treasurer regarding any expenditures.
- Aim to increase the recruitment of new and retention of existing players.
- Ensure wellbeing of all participants in the Women's Amateur team is considered.
- Support the team manager to ensure that we have the required game day participants. (ie: trainer, runner, etc).
- Support the Team Manager, Merchandise Officer, and Committee to ensure all players have the required playing uniform prior to the season commencing.
- Attend League meetings as required.
