

# Parents Code of Conduct

## The below Code of Conduct is applicable to all Hills Rangers Club Parents

- All parents must understand and adhere to the WAFC By Law 1- The Spirit of Junior Football
- Encourage children to participate in sport and have fun.
- Recognise the value and importance of volunteer coaches, managers, and helpers.
- Encourage children to always participate according to the rules.
- Encourage players to follow the rules and the umpires decisions.
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- Remember that children learn best from example. Applaud good plays by both teams.
- If you disagree with an official, raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than questioning the officials judgement in public.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by spectators, coaches, officials, or players.
- Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not swearing, using derogatory language, harassing players, coaches, umpires, or volunteers.
